Monday November 30 Read 1 John 1:1-2

How does John say that Jesus was a real person?

Where does John say Jesus was before became human?

Why is it important for us to believe that Jesus was a human and also the son of God?

How has Jesus became more real for you over time?

Tuesday December 1 Read John 1:3

What is one purpose the Holy Spirit have in inspiring John to write this letter. this letter?

How does knowing about Jesus lead us to have fellowship with one another?

How does John feel about telling others about Jesus?

Wednesday December 2 Read 1 John 1:5-6

When John says that God is light what does that mean to you?

How does knowing Jesus light your pathway as you go about your daily life?

What does it mean to walk in the darkness? In the physical world darkness is the absence of light.

Do you think this same principle applies to the Spiritual world?

How has fellowship with Jesus lighted you life?

Thursday December 3 Read 1 John 1:7

What does John say happens to our sins if we walk with Jesus?

What is another test to see that we are walking in the light?

We know that by knowing Jesus we are reconciled to God, how does knowing him reconcile us to each other?

What do you think is the relationship of being reconciled and having fellowship with each other?

Friday December 4 Read 1 John 1:8-9

If we claim to not commit sin what does John say is true about us in verse 8?

Why is it so important for us to confess our sin?

How does the light of Jesus help us to see our sins?

If one claims to be sinless what does John say about that person in verse 9?
